

EXPLORE - CONNECT - SUPPORT YOUNG PEOPLE THRIVING IN A CAREER IN AGRICULTURE



Up to 60 students who identify they would like to further EXPLORE careers in Fishing, Wool, and Dairy will move through to the CONNECT phase.

Students will be split into three groups depending on their area of interest (Fishing, Wool, and Dairy). As part of the CONNECT phase students will participate in COMMUNICATE and INTEGRATE online workshops with Josh Farr of Campus Consultancy.



COMMUNICATE (HOW TO HAVE GREAT CONVERSATIONS)

How do you have great conversations with new people? In this workshop, you will learn how to master communication through body language, tone of voice and word choice. You will see that the majority of your communication comes down to how well you can influence your own thoughts and feelings and be clear in asking great questions. You will have the confidence to ask a business the questions that will allow you to make informed decisions about whether that business is the right fit for you.

OUTCOMES:

- → Identify the 3 pillars of communication.
- ✓ Utilize the THINK model of effective communication.
- Learn how to ask great questions and develop rapport.
- Practice communication and receive feedback.
- job choices.

INTEGRATE (HOW TO CONNECT WITH THE INDUSTRY)

How do you build connections within your industry? In this workshop, you will learn how to find and connect with people and organisations that can help you expand your networks and increase your job prospects. You will hear from professionals who have worked in your field of interest and learn about events you may attend, great people you can follow on social media and take action towards becoming a young leader in your space.

OUTCOMES:

- → Meet and learn from professionals in the field.
- Connect with organisations and influencers.
- \rightarrow Develop skills in networking.
- Put networking skills to practice in live time.

ADVOCATE

(HOW TO UNDERSTAND WHAT EMPLOYERS ARE LOOKING FOR AND COMMUNICATE YOUR STRENGTHS)

How do you sell your skills to land your dream job? In this workshop, you will learn the hidden tips to reflecting, articulating and sharing the skills you have gained and how to identify transferrable skills that employers are looking for that you didn't even know you had!

OUTCOMES:

- → Reflect on your experiences that employers will value.
- ➔ Identify each step in the S.T.A.R. Method.
- Create examples using the S.T.A.R. Method.
- → Practice sharing your examples to gain confidence.
- Build capacity to see if the role and the business are the right fit for you.
